Proposed changes to the TEAM Constitution

Article 7 : The Institutions of TEAM

Delete *The Nomination Committee*

Article 9 : Work of the Annual General Meeting

Delete "*and the Nomination Committee*" Add "*and*" before "*the Co-ordinator*"

Article 10 : Board elections

Delete whole paragraph and replace with

TEAM affiliated organisations may nominate candidates for the Board, These nominations will be notified to TEAM affiliates six weeks before the AGM.

Article 11 : The Board

Delete last sentence of first paragraph "*Members of the Board, and the Coordinator, may not hold their posts for more than three years in a row, with the possibility of re-election after a lapse of one year.*"

Article 12 : Work of the Board

Delete "*Propose candidates for the Nomination Committee.*"

Change "*Supervise the work of the Secretary General...*" to "*Supervise the work of a Secretary General...*"
